Ms. Browner,

On January 20, 2000 you received and acknowledged a certified letter
that established a basis for a formal investigation into the
"chemtrail/contrail" issue.

The original request was deflected by you to a division of your
agency which replied with a description of conventional contrails.
This letter was accompanied by a ground sample that possessed unique,
unusual and hazardous properties. Furthermore, the conditions of
collection warranted a thorough investigation of both environmental
and health aspects to protect the public's well being. You have yet to
identify this sample.

Your period of inaction now exceeds 120 days. It is now evident that
you are negligent within your duties as a public servant. During
this four month period, additional incriminating evidence has
