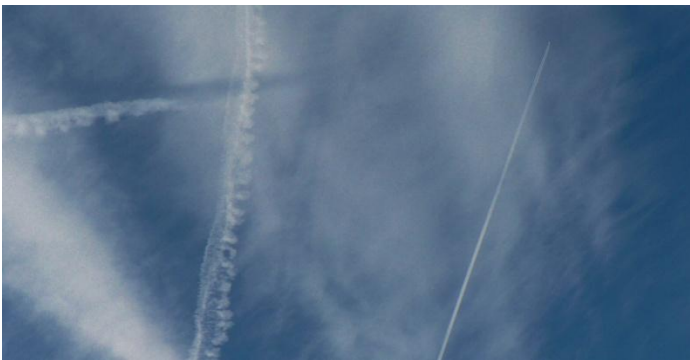
[Morgellons: A Thesis](#) : this paper describes the significant disruption and role of iron that is associated with the Morgellons condition.
